St Charles Early Childhood (SCEC) - Jaynee Brannen

St. Charles and Holy Ghost Elementary – Kayla Bahnub

- St. Charles, students and teachers have worked very hard to put on an Advent program, which took place last night, Dec. 12. Students performed songs and a Nativity play.
- On November 28, in conjunction with St. Charles Early Childhood, we put on a Soup Supper for current 4K and Kindergarten families. It was such a wonderful night! Parents had the opportunity to meet one another, students had the chance to see the kindergarten classrooms and meet the teachers, and we all ate some really wonderful soup! Thank you to all the early childhood and food service staff who helped make this event a success!
- We are continuing our work with our Superkids curriculum via virtual coaching sessions. Teachers video recorded lessons, reflected on lessons and methods for improvement, and then

shared suggestions with Lisa Darling, an expert from Superkids. This has been very productive for our professional growth.

- Holy Ghost, we will host our Advent program tomorrow night. Students have been working very hard to put on a spectacular show. On December 7.
- Holy Ghost hosted the WQOW Weather Academy with Nick Grunseth. Thank you to HandS for putting on this wonderful event!
- Holy Ghost students were also featured saying the Pledge of Allegiance on WAXX 104.5 the week of Dec. 4-8. They did a fantastic job!
- Teachers have been hard at work researching a new ELA program for grades 3-5. We plan to pilot the ReadyGEN English Language Arts program in February.

McDonell Central Catholic High School – Brian Schulner

- The play this year is the Wizard of Oz. Cast and crew have been selected. Sets are being built and rehearsals being held. The play will be performed Friday, Saturday, and Sunday February 2-4. The dress rehearsal will be performed for our Catholic Schools Celebration on February 1st.
- A new schedule (that will work) has been proposed to staff and parents. It incorporates all four blocks but introduces 2- 43 minute class periods to separate band and choir. Every student will be required to take a 43-minute course at mid-day. The other 43 minute class is at the end of the day which will be an all school resource period with every teacher available to assist students. The only class running that period will be choir. Staff have had some concerns and we have made some adjustments. Putting two "regular" class periods in took time off the blocks. We propose the high school going until 3:30 p.m. next year. I have had a dozen or so responses from parents. They support the change. We are working on updating the course handbook along with adding some new courses.
- Community day is Friday December 22, 2017. Tradition will continue with the high school students going out and performing service to their community.
- On December 22nd the Notre Dame Middle School Students have been offered the opportunity to go see "Star" an animated movie (from the animal's perspective) of the nativity. Students were given the expectations that need to be maintained until the 22nd to earn attendance.
- We will again be hosting surrounding schools to celebrate Catholic Schools Week on February 1st. We are welcoming Menomonie Saint Joseph Elementary this year as they intend to bring over 110 students to the McDonell Campus. A mass is planned, fun activities for the elementary students and a performance of the Wizard of OZ for upper grades during the afternoon.
