#### **Principal Reports**

#### Early Childhood:

- BB4C graduation will be on Friday, June 2 at 8:00 a.m. in the SC gym
- There are 32 students enrolled in BB4C for the upcoming school year. Last year at this time we had 33 enrolled.

#### 2016/2017

44 BB4C students enrolled at SCEC

20 of 29, 2017/2018, Kindergarten students will be from SCEC BB4C

45% of BB4C students will stay at SC to make up 69% of the Kindergarten class

# Weekly childcare numbers for Fall (this DOES NOT INCLUDE Supers)

44 students signed up for childcare services in the fall - this does not include Supers.

28 students enrolled for 5 days of care

5 students enrolled for 4 days of care

8 students enrolled for 3 days of care

3 students signed up for 1 or 2 day drop in care

#### Elementary report:

1. Move Up Day was successful. All students had the opportunity to get a feel for what the next academic year holds for them.

2. In particular the new batch of KG students were welcomed to the SC. This will be the Class of 2030. We have 31 new students to date.

3. We continue to advertise for a suitable Spanish teacher for both SC and HG.

4. Staff Evaluations using the Educator Effectiveness Framework are in progress and will be completed by the end of May.

5. Monthly Data Talks with each grade level teacher and the Interventionist and the Director of Instructions are held every month. Progress monitoring is now on going for a select number of our students in need of extra support.

6. Macs in Motion will now be held on May 25 so that our BB4C students can also participate

7. We are continuing to build a schedule for the next academic year that will ensure that all classroom teachers have at least one hour per day, of collaborative time when they can meet with their teaching partners and discuss the common goals for their grade levels. They can also use this time to review and monitor the standardized tests and also any other formative or summative assessments. This can also be used for additional support given to students in need.

- 8. Donuts with Dads will be held after Mass on May 31 hosted by KG students.
- 9. Ms. Rita Novak is retiring and we have advertised for a Grade 1 teacher.
- 10. All other teachers are returning and have signed their contracts

11. Grade 4 and 5 had a very educational trip to Madison. They visited the State Capitol, the Veterans Museum and the State Historical Museum. They talked to Rep. Rob Summerfield.

- 12. Senator Terry Moulton will visit them at Holy Ghost on June 1st.
- 13. The 4th grade will attend "The Past Passed Here" on May 12th and
- 14. The 3rd grade will visit the Carson Park Museum and Paul Bunyan Camp on June 1st.
- 15. Holy Ghost will hold its final Mass and Awards Ceremony on June 6th, the last day of school.

# Mary Huffcutt:

Accreditation and Leadership

 Staff completed general goal statements for accreditation. Currently working on putting them in strategic planning formatting. Key areas already working on include the reviewing, revision and communication the mission/vision; developing and implementing new teacher induction/mentoring program; using assessments meaningfully in making decisions on instruction to ensure student growth; developing a program/system to help students with learning needs.

Professional Development

- Master's Program Cohort 6: Brittany Halverson (middle school), Jill Ritchie (middle school), Brianna Krause (Kindergarten)
- Shannon Jaeger (2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher) is pursuing a reading certification (#316)
- Using the accreditation results and teacher input, the principals and Mary are working on a three year professional development plan
- Student special needs consultant, Pam Foegen, is doing observations and talking with teachers to help with the student support services plan that will begin in the 2017-18 school year.

Assessments

- Students in grades 6-10 are taking the ACT-Aspire summative assessments. Results should be available end of June.
- K-5 students are taking the spring term Aimsweb assessment

Curriculum

- Middle school and high school science programs will anticipate new textbooks/materials for 2017-18 school year
- Grades 3 and 5 are piloting a new English Language Arts curriculum (Experiential Learning). Fourth grade will participate next fall.
- Representation from the teachers at St. Charles will visit Grant school in Wausau to observe their instruction of the Superkids (literacy program)
