Supporting Parish Members and the McDonell Area Catholic Schools

The Relationship of Our Parishes and Schools

The McDonell Area Catholic Schools rely on local parish subsidies for roughly 25% of their total budget. This represents tremendous commitment and generosity shared among all parishioners. It is extremely important that families benefiting from their parishes' commitment demonstrate equal commitment to their parish with their time, talent and treasure. In a fundamental and valuable sense, our schools belong to our parishes. The parishes built the schools, hundreds of parishioners are alumni of our schools, and without strong parishes our schools cannot exist.

Supporting Parish Membership & Tuition Assistance

When considering families' eligibility for supporting parish member tuition, the pastors and parishioners of each of our supporting parishes consider each of the following factors in determining whether any given family is currently an active member of their parish. We encourage each family to be able to answer "yes" to the following questions:

- Is this family registered with one of our supporting parishes?
- Does this family keep in communion and participate in Holy Mass?
- Does this family offer their parish their time, talent, and/or treasure, however limited?
- Does this family respond through their parish to the Bishop's Annual Appeal insofar as their means allow?
- Does this family accept the Catholic educational mission of their parish and our school system?

Enrollment Procedures, Tuition Payment Options, and Financial Aid

Enrollment: Open enrollment begins January 31, 2021 for the 2021-2022 school year. All current and new families will need to complete a **three part process** to enroll your child(ren).

1. *MACS Online Registration (MOR)* – The MOR link for [new families](#) is located on the MACS website under Admissions – Enrollment-New K-12 Families Registration Link. Current families please log into the parent portal for Infinite Campus. You can log into Infinite Campus by going to the MACS website under Parents –Infinite Campus –Campus Parent-More-Online registration. Contact k.adams@macs.k12.wi.us if you need your username and/or password for Infinite Campus.
2. *Part 2 MOR Financial Form* – after submitting Part 1 (MOR), you will receive a confirmation email with a link to complete MOR Part 2. If you do not receive this email within a few minutes, please check your spam or junk mail.
3. *Family Enrollment Fee* – A non-refundable \$100 enrollment fee is needed to complete registration. A link to pay the family enrollment fee will be at the end of MOR Part 2. [The fee may be paid online \(Paypal, Debit or Credit Card\)](#) or by sending a check or cash to one of the school offices.
Please note: for re-enrolling families, this fee increases to \$150 after March 5, 2021.

ALL discounts (scrip, scholarships, Guardian Angel Scholarship Fund, and referral discount) will be calculated by the central office before sending out the tuition billing statements in **August, 2021**.

Guardian Angel Scholarship Fund Program: (Formally Tuition Assistance & Adopt-A-Student)

We are not a **zero** tuition school (unless you are enrolled in WI Parental Choice Program); however, we make every effort for families to be able to afford a Catholic education. Our Guardian Angel Scholarship Fund program is on a first come first serve basis. Once we reach our budgeted amount allowed by the fund, this program may not be available to your family. **Please apply as early as possible.** All families who wish to qualify for the Guardian Angel Scholarship Program **must** complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Application online at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FDCZ>. The deadline for current families to do so is **April 30, 2021**.

The Guardian Angel Scholarship Process:

1. Complete the three part enrollment process.
2. Complete and submit the FACTS Grant & Aid Application online. FACTS will charge a \$30 processing fee. Once your application is complete, FACTS Grant & Aid will submit their results to the McDonell Area Catholic Schools Central Office. Current families should complete the online process by or before **April 30, 2021**.
3. The data from FACTS will be processed by the Central Office and a Scholarship will be awarded based on their analysis. Guardian Angel Scholarship Contracts will be mailed out sometime in May or June.
4. If you accept the amount, then sign and return the Guardian Angel Scholarship contract.
5. If you have questions about the amount of the scholarship awarded based on the analysis from Facts Grant & Aid, please contact the Central Office to set up an appointment to speak with the President.

Tuition Automatic Payment Plan using FACTS:

FACTS is a third-party tuition management company widely employed by Catholic and other private schools. The FACTS program allows you to pay your tuition in timely, manageable installments, while also providing our school system with reasonable assurance that your tuition will be paid. The system is confidential and secure,

and operates like most other automatic withdrawal payment systems. **You can have payments withdrawn from checking, savings or even your credit card (a 2.75% fee applies with credit card use).** Families can now create an account with FACTS to view payments at: <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FDCZ>.

If you currently have a FACTS account and wish to continue, you will automatically be reenrolled at the start date that you choose in the enrollment process. **We are now offering lump sum withdrawals for tuition as well.**

Payment Options:

- Set up an account to make one lump sum tuition payment in August 2021.
- Set up an account to make 2 payments, one in August 2021 and the second in March 2022.
- Set up an account to make 11 monthly payments beginning in July 2021.
- Set up an account to make 10 monthly payments beginning in August 2021.

If you have a FACTS account set up, we can now offer lunch payments and other fees to be deducted from your account either in a lump sum or monthly withdrawals. Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) - Open Enrollment

McDonnell Area Catholic Schools offers the WPCP with the State of Wisconsin at our schools. Each year there is an open enrollment process which coincides with our school's open enrollment. We encourage all families who are income eligible to apply to this program. **All students who are currently in the program will need to re-apply as well.**

1. Open enrollment begins February 1, 2021 through April 15, 2021.
2. Income bracket guideline charts can be found on our website ADMISSIONS - WPCP
3. Go to <http://dpi.wi.gov/SMS/choice-programs/student-applications> to apply.
4. Bring in your **signed** and **dated** Federal 1040 tax documents along with proof of residency (**Current** utility bill, W2 or payroll stub) prior to the enrollment process ending so MACS can verify your residency.
5. If you have questions about the enrollment process, please feel free to set up an appointment with the MACS Business Office and we will be happy to walk you through the application.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) - Families with Vouchers

Students who currently are in WPCP will continue until they graduate from our school system. However, you will be required to log into your family account that was created during last year's enrollment and accept your voucher for the 2021-2022 school year. You will then need to bring in a copy of a **current** utility bill, W2 or payroll stub so MACS can re-verify your residency. The website is <http://dpi.wi.gov/SMS/choice-programs/student-applications>. **We also require you to complete online enrollment to update Infinite Campus.**

2021 Wisconsin State Tax Credit-Private School Tuition

In 2013, the State of Wisconsin signed into law Act 20, sec.71.05(6)(b)49., effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2014. Tuition paying families will qualify for a subtraction from income for tuition paid in the tax year up to a certain dollar amount paid by the claimant. Please ask your tax preparer if you have any additional questions.

2021-22 Time and Talent Commitment

Fundraising and Volunteering:

Revenues from fundraisers are a major source of income for our schools and its affiliated parent organizations. We organize our fundraising to minimize demands on families' time and pocketbooks. Everyone's participation is needed and appreciated.

Each MACS family is required to perform at least 30 hours of volunteer service to the school system as a condition of enrollment.

Volunteering to work a minimum of 6 hours at our all-school fundraising events, which are the Spaghetti Spectacular and Mid-Winter Mardi Gras, is required for the financial support of our schools.

Using Scrip:

Scrip is one of MACS greatest fundraisers and we encourage all families to make every effort to use our Scrip program on a regular basis. Many local retailers along with nearly all of the major stores participate in the Scrip program. When Scrip gift cards are used, MACS receives fifty percent of the proceeds. The remaining fifty percent is credited towards a MACS family tuition, a local parish or to MACS. If you receive tuition assistance, your Scrip purchases are factored into the assistance awarded.

Scrip purchased July 1 through June 30 will be credited to the following school year tuition balance.

We apply half of the scrip rebate toward your family's tuition for the following school year.

The Education Alliance and the Total Cost to Educate

What is the Education Alliance?

This is an agreement between our parents and administration to fully educate families about the **Total Cost** of educating a student. It is our hope that each family will prayerfully consider to make an attempt, as best as possible, to meet the **Total Cost** of their children's education.

Total Average Cost to Educate

The **Total Average Cost** to educate a **K-8** student at MACS is \$8,500.

The **Total Average Cost** to educate a **9-12** student at MACS is \$11,700.

Why am I being asked to make a gift?

The **Total Cost** is not what you pay for your child's education. It is our firm belief that Catholic education should be affordable and accessible for all families. It is challenging to secure the necessary funds to achieve a balanced budget and maintain the quality education that you expect for your children. We ask you to consider making a donation to help bridge the "difference" between the **Total Cost** and our MACS Tuition.

FAQ about the Education Alliance gift

Will we still be able to receive financial assistance if we make a donation?

This gift will have **no** impact on the financial assistance a family may receive. Financial assistance is our commitment to make Catholic education affordable and accessible. However, it is our hope that every family will consider a commitment to the Education Alliance Program **to the best of their ability**.

Is our donation tax deductible?

Yes! Any gift over the required stated tuition is considered a donation and therefore tax deductible if you itemize. Please check with your accountant to discuss your charitable giving and the positive impact it can have on your tax liability.

Are we expected to make our Education Alliance charitable contribution at this time?

No. We invite you to maximize your support by making easy and affordable installment payments during the 2021-2022 school year.

If we make a donation to the Education Alliance, do we have to participate in other advancement activities?

Yes. It is expected that every family will participate to the best of their ability in **ALL** of our efforts to help raise money to offset our operating costs, keeping expenses low and to provide **value** with enhancements such as teaching tools and technology. This includes volunteering your time and talent at events throughout the year including Spaghetti Spectacular and Mardi Gras.
