Who can be tested?

Any Wisconsin residents 5 years and older with at least one of the following symptoms: fever, cough, loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath, sore throat, fatigue, body aches, diarrhea, vomiting, nausea, chills, or muscle aches can get tested.

What should I expect when going?

Be prepared for a potential wait time. There will not be public restrooms available. The National Guard will be doing the testing. Expect them to be in full PPE (personal protective equipment), including gowns and masks.
