

What to expect if your child is a close contact



FIRST: A phone call

Parents will first get a phone call from the school's principal letting you know your child is a close contact. If your child has had COVID-19 in the past 6 months or has been vaccinated, a quarantine will not be required. We will use the honor system.



SECOND: Schoolwork

After a quarantine has been issued to your child, teachers will provide class materials to them by day 2 (two) of the quarantine. Parents or students may contact teachers with any questions.



THIRD: COVID-19 test (optional)

At least 4 (four) days after the determined point of close contact, the child under quarantine can get tested for COVID-19. Home or lab tests are acceptable.



FOURTH: Back to school

If your child has received a negative COVID-19 test, they may come back to school immediately after confirming the results with the school principal. Or, your student may return to school 10 (ten) days after exposure, without symptoms.
