

WISCONSIN PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM



WHAT IS THE WISCONSIN SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM?

The state of Wisconsin has a program that allows eligible students to attend a participating private school in grades K-12. The private school, on behalf of the student's parents and guardian, receives a state aid payment for each eligible student.



HOW IS A STUDENT ELIGIBLE?

Student eligibility is based on a combination of student residency, income and age. Students from a public school may apply for any grade. All students must provide documentation that they live in the state of Wisconsin. Acceptable documentation includes a utility bill, W-2, or mortgage statement.



WHAT IS THE INCOME REQUIREMENT?

Parents of Choice students must provide a copy of their current year taxes showing that income does not exceed the income limits.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Each year, families must apply at **dpi.wi.gov/choice**. The application period is February – April, each year. Current Choice families are required to re-apply.
