



MACS Spectator Policy - Fall 2020



Due to the limitations related to COVID-19, McDonnell Area Catholic Schools will be implementing the following spectator policies for the Fall 2020 season:

- Spectators will be limited to a max of four (4) tickets per student-athlete and paid coach. Both home and visiting immediate household members will be allowed to attend.
- Each host school will have the final determination on how many spectators are able to attend their event. Please confirm with the coach or the Athletic Director **BEFORE** traveling to an away competition.
- Immediate household members can only attend events when their son or daughter is competing.
- Ticket passes will be given out prior to each event for immediate household members.
 - There will still be a ticket charge for events held at our facilities (high school)
 - Spectators are expected to fill out the following information on the ticket prior to arrival:
 - Name, Address and Phone Number
 - By accepting a ticket, spectators are accepting the responsibility to wear face coverings for the duration of the event, both indoor and outdoor
 - If there is non-compliance, allowing ANY spectators will be discontinued
- Strict mitigation procedures (masks, sanitizer, physical distancing) will be in effect at all events.
- No public attendance allowed
- Most schools will be offering a livestream option for at least varsity. Some schools may livestream lower level games if feasible. Streaming details will be shared by the host school prior to the event.

We will comply with local Public Health officials and reserve the right to turn away spectators at any time.
