



# MACS Winter Sports Protocols

Due to the limitations related to COVID-19, McDonell Area Catholic Schools will be implementing the following spectator policies for the Winter 2020-21 season:



## **Screening/Social Distancing**

- Masks and physical distancing are required at all events. All spectators/fans, players, coaches, officials and game personnel are required to wear masks per Cloverbelt Conference rules.
- Teams should come dressed and ready to play **no more than 30 minutes prior to game time**. Locker rooms will not be available.
- MACS fans shall sit physically distanced (minimal 6 feet) from each other behind the scorers table. Visiting fans shall sit on the opposite side of the gym from the scorers table.
- Each host school will have the final determination on how many spectators are able to attend their event. Please confirm with the coach or the Athletic Director **BEFORE** traveling to an away competition.
- Strict mitigation procedures (masks, sanitizer, physical distancing) will be in effect at all events.
  - Socially distanced sections will be marked throughout the bleachers. Fans are expected to sit in those locations throughout the duration of the competition.
- There will be no concessions available during competitions. Water bottle filling stations will be available.

## **Admission**

- Spectators will be limited to a max of **two (2) guardian admissions** per student-athlete and paid coach. Both home and visiting **guardians** will be allowed to attend.
  - Guardians will only be allowed to attend events when their son or daughter is competing.
  - Spectators should arrive **no earlier than 15 minutes prior** to the start of their child's game. At the completion of the competition we ask all to immediately exit the school building. We will be clearing the gym between levels.
  - Events held at Holy Ghost Elementary will be limited to **one (1) guardian admission** per student-athlete.
- A pass list will be provided by both the home and visiting school with guardians names.
  - There will not be an admission charge, but donations are welcomed
  - By entering the building, spectators are accepting the responsibility to wear face coverings for the duration of the event.
  - If there is non-compliance, of any of the rules, allowing ANY spectators will be discontinued
- No public attendance allowed

## **Livestream**

- Most schools will be offering a livestream option for at least varsity. Some schools may livestream lower level games if feasible. Streaming details will be shared by the host school prior to the event.
