




#### 1. Where are you a parish member?


### 2. How long have you been a member of the parish?


#### 3. What is your age group?






6. Which of the options best advances the mission of the Catholic Church in Chippewa Falls?


7. Do you support St. Peter being a part of the merging or clustering of the parishes in Chippewa Falls?




9. How willing are you to consider contributing financially over the next several years to a capital campaign? This is above and beyond your current giving to the parish.


