The trip will be June 5-16, and it's been something I've had in mind for a while. Although I had my doubts it would ever happen after my first year here was ended abruptly by the pandemic, things around the world have cleared up, and I'm still here! We'll be joining up with six students from Newman High School in Wausau along with their chaplain and three other adults for our travels.
